Kind attention is invited to the reference cited. I am to inform you that based on the inspection conducted in your College for granting Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2024-25, the Scrutiny Committee has pointed out the following deficiencies: -

1. Built up area of practice of Medicine, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Repertory & Surgery departments are insufficient
2. IP & OP strength are insufficient.
3. Faculties are insufficient in the Dept. of Physiology & Bio-Chemistry and Pathology

Therefore, it is requested to rectify the aforementioned deficiencies /offer remarks and submit a compliance report along with an affidavit in stamp paper Rs 200/- within 15 days from the date of receipt of this letter, with sufficient proof to support your claim of rectification, and remit the re inspection / re consideration fee of **Rs. 21000/-** (Rupees Twenty One Thousand only), through ONLINE (Principal Login >Payments >Miscellaneous Payments >Select purpose as Re inspection Fee) in order to further processing of your application for granting CoPA 2024-25.



I hereby submit the compliance report addressing the deficiencies recently identified by the Inspection Scrutiny Committee in regard to our facilities. Also consider the actions taken and measures implemented to rectify the identified shortcomings.

### 1. Built up area of Practice of Medicine, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Repertory & Surgery Departments insufficient

At the time of inspection, expansion construction activities initiated by the management were underway, necessitating some departments to relocate to smaller, more constricted areas. Please note that as the expansion works near completion, additional space has recently been allocated to the departments previously constrained, providing them with more room to operate effectively..

- PM department was functioning in an area of  $28.4$  sq.m and is now allocated a separate space for museum of an area  $17.2$  sq.m. So now the total area comes to  $456$  sq.m.
- Surgery Department is now shifted to new area in the hospital block & it comes to  $24.40$  sq.m. Apart from this it has an additional  $20.2$  sq.m allotted to museum.
- The Repertory Department, as stipulated by the MSR guidelines, necessitates a workspace measuring 40 square meters. At present, the department is operating within an ample space of 44 square meters.
- The Obstetrics and Gynaecology department is set to occupy a substantial area of  $37.8$  sq.m in the current expansion project, and it will be relocated soon as it is nearing completion

### 2. IP & OP Strength insufficient

As per MSR regulations, the OPD & IPD must be ..... respectively. On average, we manage approximately ..... outpatient & ..... Inpatient services daily and in order to expand our reach, we have initiated & running additional 6 peripheral outpatient operations. Furthermore, for educational purposes, students and interns are also being assigned posting within these Peripheral OPDs.

Moreover, the Outpatient Department has been moved to the newly expanded area of our hospital block and now the OPD section itself has an area of ..... Sq.m. Additionally, we are in the final stages of constructing our new In-Patient block.  $132.4$

### 3. Faculties are insufficient in the Department of Physiology & Pathology

As our institution is a government-aided college, it is imperative that all permanent and full-time appointments are executed only after receiving prior authorization from the state government. This process should include the establishment of a Selection Committee to ensure compliance with regulations. Despite the fact that management has reported available positions, the procedure remains pending government approval.

Meanwhile, Dr Thara P (Reader, Department of Physiology) & Dr Bindulekshmi (Reader, Department of Pathology) have qualified for PG through AIPGET in the year 2022-2023. Recognizing the undeniable entitlement to pursue advanced education, the management accommodated their request and granted permission to do PG on a deputation basis. In order to satisfy the lacunae, guest appointees have been brought in the relevant departments.

In the Department of Physiology, Dr S Vijayakumari (Rtd. Professor from GHMC) is appointed as Professor (Guest) & Dr Anju G Krishnan as Assistant Professor (Guest) [Ref No. ....]. Dr. Arun S Raj, Medical Officer and holder of an MD degree, is currently conducting classes on work arrangements.

In the Department of Pathology Dr Shiny Mathew (Lecturer & Permanent faculty) is available and instead of Dr Bindulekshmi who has gone for PG, Dr Akhila A L has been appointed as Assistant Professor (Guest). Dr D Reghu, Reader & HOD has been on LWVA for a period of ..... months due to medical reasons and he will be joining soon. Also the present Second BHMS students is currently engaged in university examinations, and the next batch class will not commence until after August, there are no active students within our current second-year course. Additionally, we are actively seeking an experienced faculty member who can adeptly fill the role of Associate Reader.

I hereby submit the compliance report addressing the deficiencies recently identified by the Inspection Scrutiny Committee in regard to our facilities. Also consider the actions taken and measures implemented to rectify the identified shortcomings.

1. Built up area of Practice of Medicine, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Repertory & Surgery Department insufficient.

At the time of inspection, expansion construction activities initiated by the management were underway, necessitating some departments to relocate to smaller, more constricted area. Please note that as the expansion works near completion, additional space has recently been allocated to the departments previously constrained providing them with more room to operate effectively.

- (a) Practice of Medicine Department was functioning in an area of 28.4 sq.m. and is now allocated a separate space for museum of an area 17.2 sq.m. So now the total area comes to 45.6 sq.m.
- (b) Surgery Department is now shifted to new area in the hospital block and it comes to 24.40 sq.m. Apart from this it has an additional 20.2 sq.m. allotted to museum.
- (c) The Repertory Department as stipulated by the MSR guidelines necessitates a workspace measuring 40 square meters. At present, the department is operating within an ample space of 44 square meters.
- (d) The Obstetrics & Gynaecology department is set to occupy a substantial area of 37.8 sq.m in the current expansion project, and it will be relocated soon as it is nearing completion.

## 2. IP & OP Strength insufficient

As per MSR regulations the OPD & IPD must be 120 & 6 (our IP strength is 20 here) respectively. On average, we manage approximately outpatient and Inpatient services daily and in order to expand our reach, we have initiated and running additional 6 peripheral outpatient operations. Furthermore, for educational purposes, students and interns are also being assigned posting within these Peripheral OPDs.

Moreover, the Outpatient Department has been moved to the newly expanded area of our hospital block and now the OPD section itself has an area of 134.7 sq.m. Additionally, we are in the final stages of constructing our new In-Patient block.

In conjunction with World Autism Day, we are expanding our Neurodevelopmental Speciality OPD, now complemented by a dedicated rehabilitation unit comprising Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Sensory Unit & Park, Psychotherapy. This progressive expansion spans an area of 108.2 sq.m.

This will undoubtedly enhance the outpatient and inpatient inflow, whilst simultaneously elevating student exposure to subsequent stages.
